

# Tract 7260 Sues Los Angeles

The Tract No. 7260 Association, Inc., has sued the City of Los Angeles. The suit asks the City to rescind its approval of the Trammell Crow Environmental Impact Report for a proposed 15 story 778,947 square foot building which would replace the 678,822 square foot ABC Entertainment Center.

The suit seeks a proper and accurate impact report on the traffic impact of the project. Tract 7260 is deeply concerned with any project that would add more traffic to our already gridlocked streets.

Tract No. 7260 is represented in this case by Strumwasser & Woocher, the same law firm that represented it in its case against Constellation Place (now the MGM Towers) a case that ended with 7260 receiving a generous settlement. The lead attorney in the case is Fred Woocher, who is assisted by Sam Goodstein.
