Bennett, Yaroslavsky, Feuer to Speak At 7260 Annual Meeting on May 12

How Westwood Charter School works, Valley Secession, crime, and Santa Monica Blvd. will be among the topics discussed by **Westwood Charter School Principal Michelle Bennett, Supervisor Zev Yaroslavsky, and Councilman Mike Feuer.**

The three will be the main speakers at Tract No. 7260's annual meeting on Wednesday, May 12 at the Social Hall of St. Timothy's Church (just west of Beverly Glen on Pico Blvd.) at 7:30 p.m.

Stage Deli Dinner

Prior to the meeting, all Tract No. 7260 members and their guests are invited to a dinner catered by the Stage Deli. The dinner will be served from 6:30 to 7:30 p.m.

Supervisor Yaroslavsky, who was the force behind the successful ballot measure that killed future local tax funding for the Los Angeles subway system, will discuss alternatives to the subway including smart lanes and long buses that carry 250 passengers.

Councilman Feuer will cover issues ranging from tree trimming to the city's aging infrastructure.

Decreasing Crime Rates

A top officer of the West Los Angeles Division of the LAPD will join Senior Lead Officer Terry Schauer to talk about the decreasing crime rates on the West Side. The two also will discuss what 7260 residents can do to decrease those crime rates even further.
