

Councilman Jack Weiss to Draw Bead on Terrorism At Tract No. 7260's Annual Meeting

In his annual address to the Tract No. 7260 Association on Tuesday, May 13, 2003, Councilman Jack Weiss will discuss "How safe is LA from Terrorists and Disease. The talk will be part of the program at the annual dinner meeting of the Association at the Social Hall of St. Timothy's Church ((on Pico Blvd., one half block west of Beverly Glen.)

Prior to the councilman's talk, **a buffet dinner catered by Ugo's will be served at 6:30 p.m.** at a cost of \$4 for members* and \$8 for non-members. The annual meeting will begin at 7:30 p.m. "Why 7260 Is Fighting Trammell Crow's Proposed Huge Century City Office Building," "Crime and Tract No. 7260," "Remodeling the Westfield Shopping Town," and "How the MTA Proposes to Keep Construction on Santa Monica Boulevard from Ruining Your Disposition" will be among topics covered in committee reports.

Councilman Weiss is uniquely qualified to talk about terrorist threats in L. A. As a member of the City Council's Public Safety Committee, Councilman Weiss has helped form the city's response to threats from terrorists. In his address, the Councilman will describe what the city is doing to protect you from bitterer and chemical threats as well as from health problems such as SARS. He also will state his response to the proposed Trammell Crow project in Century City, and he will outline his plans to monitor construction on Santa Monica Blvd. In addition, he will report on how the city is reacting to the current budget crisis and how he is trying to avoid cuts in city services.

Also on the agenda will be the election of 7260's Board of Directors.
