

Fox Completes Construction on First Building

Twentieth Century Fox Studio has announced that it has completed construction on one building and is working on four other projects. The Galaxy Way Parking Structure opened last November. The eight level garage holds 1,370 vehicles. Access is from the Galaxy Way cul-de-sac just west of Avenue of the Stars.

Operations Facility

Steel framing for the Fox Broad-casting Operations Facility has been substantially completed. A subterranean parking garage in this technical facility has room for 300 cars.

When completed in January 1998, the building will be the new home of the Fox Network. All programming activities will originate from the facility. Earth station satellite dishes will transmit programming nationwide from the site.

New Executive Building

Studio executives, who currently are dispersed throughout the Fox lot, will be housed together in the New Executive Building, scheduled for completion in the Spring of 1998.

The Craft Center

The Craft Center, located centrally on the studio lot, is scheduled for a September, 1997 opening. Steel framing is underway. The building will consolidate a number of existing craft operations in one place. Those existing operations include the mill, set lighting, the film vault, and other related activities.

Pico Entrance

Renovation of the Pico entrance, including substantial landscaping and the installation of a fountain will be completed in 1998.

Murals

One project will never be completed. Using state of the art computer technology. Fox has painted five huge murals on the exterior walls of some of its buildings. The murals feature Marilyn Monroe and Tom Ewell in *The Seven Year Itch*, Luke Skywalker and Darth Vader in a Star Wars laser sword duel, a scene from *The Ox Bow Incident*, Julie Andrews singing in *The Sound of Music*, and *The Simpsons* at play

The studio plans to replace the existing murals with new ones periodically.
